Through the generosity of the Max Kade Foundation, the Department of German is pleased to offer \$1000 travel scholarships for eligible undergraduate students in order to provide financial support for study abroad programs organized by Northwestern University. Preference will be given to students with financial need who are applying for the nine-week summer program **Berlin: Global City in the Center of Europe**.\*

### ELIGIBILITY

The Max Kade Travel Scholarship (MKS) is available to degree-seeking Northwestern University undergraduate students applying to study in Germany through a Northwestern run program.

### GUIDELINES

The applicant is required to fill out the background information portion of the application, write a statement of purpose, and solicit a letter of recommendation from a Northwestern faculty member. An unofficial transcript and proof of financial aid (if applicable) is also required. The travel fund is contingent upon acceptance into the specific program to which the student has applied.

### APPLICATION

- 1) The background information portion in the following pages.
- 2) A statement of purpose, no more than one page or approximately 500 words. In the statement of purpose, students should describe their interests in the program with an indication of what they hope to accomplish by studying and living abroad.
- 3) A letter of recommendation from a faculty member with whom the student has taken a class. The letter can be sent in the form of an email.
- 4) Copy of an unofficial transcript (from Northwestern and any other university attended). The transcript may be electronic or scanned, as long as it is an unofficial printed copy from CAESAR.
